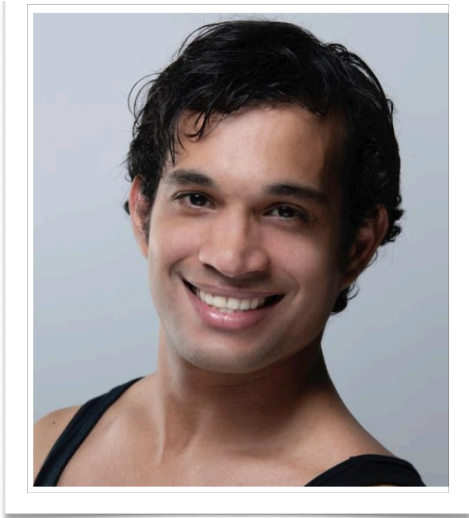

Trained at the prestigious Escuela Nacional de Ballet of Cuba, he joined the renowned Ballet Nacional de Cuba in 2010. That same year, he was promoted to Soloist with Ballet ProDanza.

In 2011, he began appearing as a Principal Guest Artist with several international companies, including Santo Domingo Ballet and Ballet Municipal de Lima in Peru, among others. In 2012, he joined Ballet de Monterrey in Mexico as a Soloist. During 2013 and 2014, he performed with Joburg Classical Ballet Company in South Africa, further expanding his international career. In 2015, he was promoted to Principal Dancer with Ballet de Monterrey.

He has taught at the Escuela Superior de Música y Danza de Monterrey and has been invited as a guest teacher at numerous schools and studios throughout Mexico and the United States.

As a choreographer, he has staged acclaimed productions and excerpts including Paquita Grand Pas, Majísimo, excerpts from The Nutcracker, and La Esmeralda (Diana and Acteon Suite).

His achievements have been recognized internationally with numerous awards, including a Gold Medal in the Cuban Ballet Competition (Pas de Deux category), a Gold Medal at the Calabria International Ballet Competition in Italy, a Gold Medal at the South Africa International Ballet Competition, and a Silver Medal in the Dominican Republic.

Since April 2022, he has served as the Artistic Director of US International Ballet.
